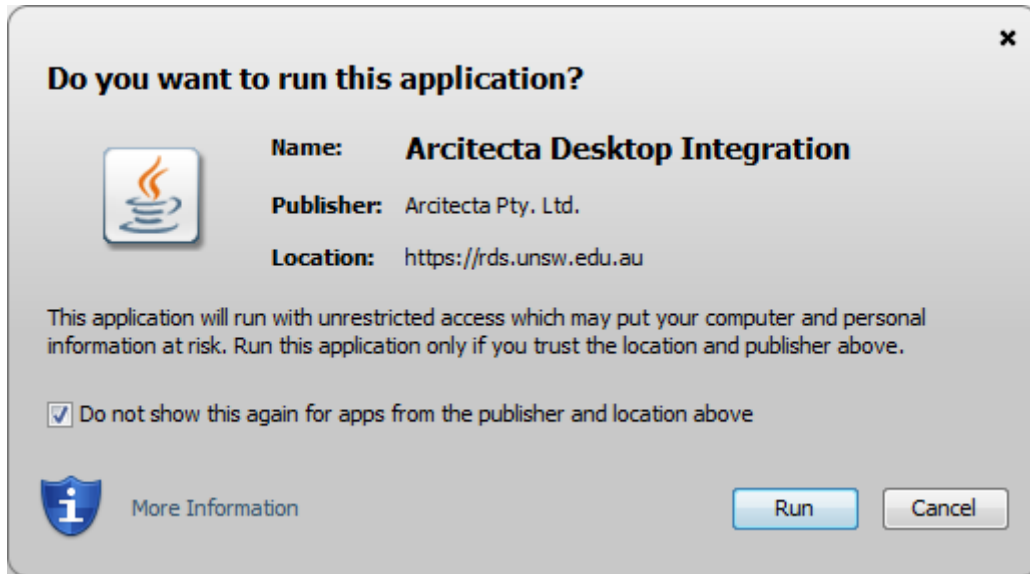


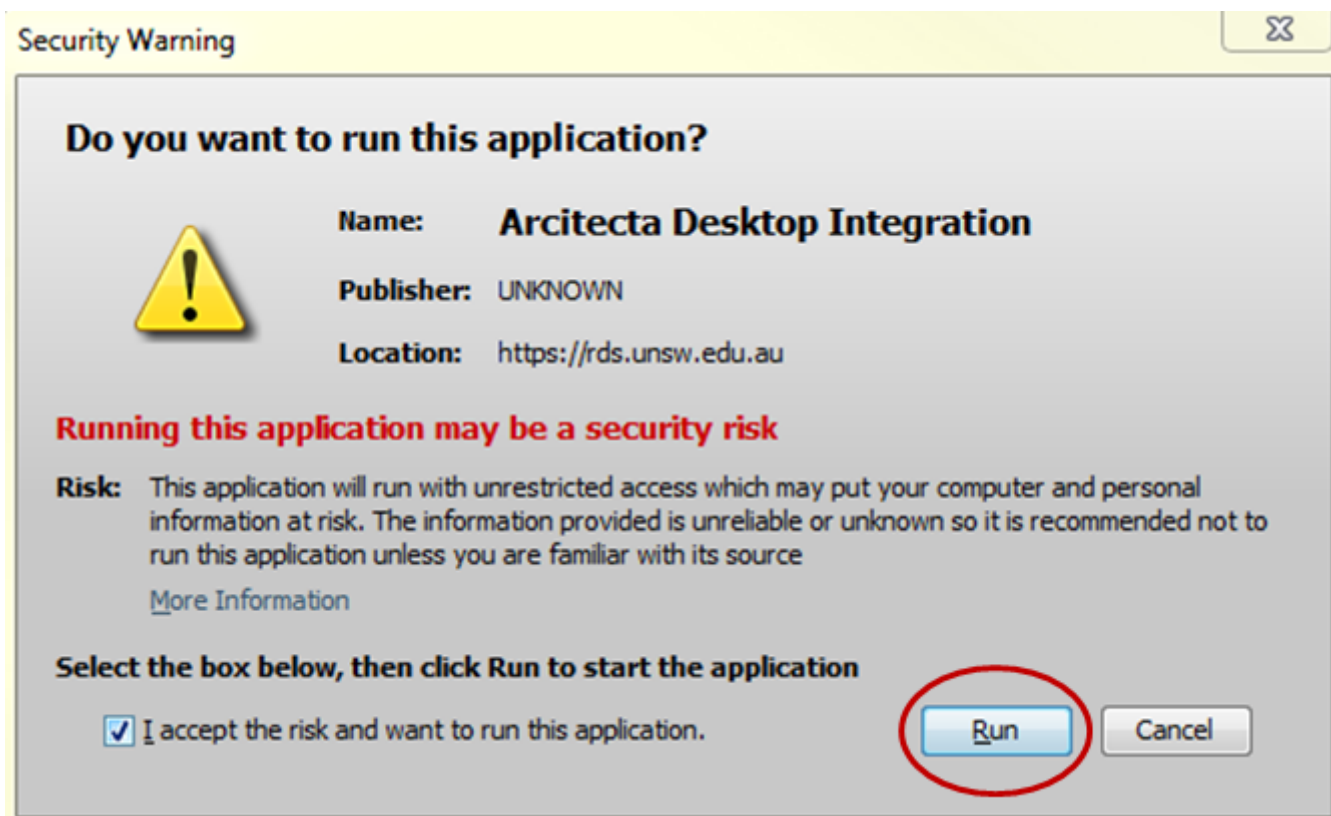

## Do you want to run this application?

When you connect to the UNSW Data Archive using the Java applet web-based user interface for the first time, one of the following two Java message may appear (Note: Mediaflux Desktop is the application which hosts the Data Archive):





If so, **check the box** which states "Do not show this again for apps from the publisher and location above" and then click on the **Run** button. This will allow Java to run automatically when you connect to the UNSW Data Archive [Java applet web-based user interface](#) in future.
